My experience working with Mark and Rick has been very positive. The single biggest thing that I've taken away is, I think, being present in conversations and truly understanding, you know, the objectives, the concerns, the issues that people are having and having empathy towards what they're going through and being able to create a solution that is aligned with their objectives.

This coaching is very different because it focuses, I think, in the real world and on relationships and human conversations and interaction, which I think is missing in the marketplace. I've increased the number of plans we've created, we've had success building our team. We've had success hiring new Administrative Managers. So yes, it's been of, of great value. Absolutely.

I've become much more client-focused, a much better, I think, listener and showing people a lot more empathy and truly trying to understand what they're trying to achieve and operate as a fiduciary and not a salesperson.
